COLLECTION SYSTEM COMPONENTS & OPERATION

The Town of Murphy's wastewater collection system, located in Cherokee County, consists of nineteen pumping stations with approximately 34 miles of collection lines. All wastewater from the collection system is transported by other pumping stations into our pump station #1, which is located approximately 2300 feet from the wastewater treatment plant. Pump station #1 pumps directly into the headworks system at the wastewater treatment plant.

The Town of Murphy currently has a wastewater treatment plant that is permitted to discharge 1.4 MGD. The treatment system is a biological activated sludge process. It uses two 750,000-gallon SBR tanks as treatment units. This new system also utilizes a sludge press to dewater the sludge prior to disposal instead of the drying beds that were used when the old plant was in service. This processed sludge will be hauled to the county's sanitary landfill for proper disposal.

SYSTEM PERFORMANCE

The Town of Murphy continues to work in many areas in order to improve the wastewater collection system. Having older pumping stations and collection lines replaced remain major priorities for the town. Town personnel regularly perform preventative maintenance, such as line jetting, root control, and smoke testing when needed. Line inspections are performed on a regular basis to ensure proper structural performance.
