Main Street Board Meeting: August 11, 2022

- The election of a Board Chair was delayed due to a lack of a quorum. The election will be addressed at the next meeting of the Board.
- Laura Lachance presented Drafts of "Murphy Main Street Board Bylaws" and "Responsibilities of the Murphy Main Street Board of Directors. Changes to these drafts were proposed by board members and Laura Lachance will update based on these suggestions. Both of these documents will be approved at the next meeting of the Board.
- Laura Lachance presented the idea of developing an "Elevator Speech" for the Murphy Main Street Program. This speech will be in the form of bullet points for board members to use when explaining the program to the community. Some of the questions it will address are: What does it mean to me? Available Grants? What is the structure?
- Laura Lachance announced that the Town of Murphy has hired a Landscape Architect to redesign the pocket parks in Downtown Murphy. This plan will be used to apply for the Rural Transformation Grant being coordinated by the NC Department of Commerce. This board and the Main Street committees will be asked to be part of the brainstorming sessions for this redesign in the coming month.

 for Street Furniture.

Tim requested that everyone brainstorm on tasks that can be accomplished that day. Laura is going to reach out to members of the Heritage Partners Board and Callie Moore of MountainTrue.
